Summary:

I. Suicide among patients with cancer

- 1) Designed a study to examine the number of suicide and suicide mortality and risk factors using information from the National Cancer Registry, which has been available since 2016. After approval by the Ethics Review Committee, data will be obtained.
- 2) Designed a study to examine sentinel events and associated factors for suicide behavior among patients with cancer in hospitals using data from databases on medical safety and obtained the data.

II. Suicide prevention measures in hospitals
